



Archery Canada (AC) Mailmatch

It is time to get organized to take part in the upcoming Archery Canada Indoor Mailmatch. See how you rank against other archers across Canada.

The Mailmatch will take place over the 12 or 13 weeks from January 1 to March 31.

Archers may submit a maximum of one score per week during this time period.

Your best 6 scores obtained during this time period will be used to calculate your average score and ranking in your age/equipment categories. As long as 6 scores are shot during the time period you can be eligible for medals.

The mail match is like two competitions in one

- First, archer's average scores will be ranked according to Archery Canada/World Archery categories where Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded.
- Second, archers can win a Gold medal if they place first in their Classification and have not won a Gold medal under the Archery Canada/World Archery category (these can be found under the Mail Match Rules).
